In 2016, 65% of the homes paid dues. **Our goal for 2017 is 75% and we have extended our deadline until July 31st for this year to reach our goal.**

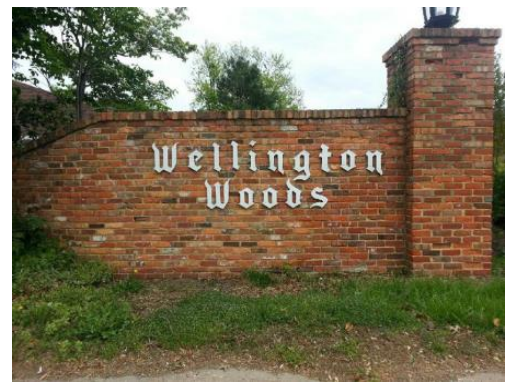
To date we are at 50%, please pay your dues to help keep our community a great place to live.

Recycling

Virginia Beach Public Works Waste Management Division is pleased to announce that plastic bottles (#1-7) as well as food and beverage cartons are now being accepted in curbside containers and at all drop-off centers.

- Paper: office paper, newspaper, junk mail, magazines, phone books, paper bags
- Cardboard & Chipboard: flattened, un-waxed, clean & dry
- Plastics Bottles # 1 -7, NO plastic bags.
- Cartons, including food and beverage cartons (juice, milk, soy milk, soup, broth, etc.)
- Glass Bottles & Jars: clear, green & brown; remove & discard lids.
- Metals: aluminum, steel, or tin food & beverage cans; clean aluminum foil

Pour out contents or wipe out cans and bottles. Place recyclables loosely in your container. Please do not put the following items in your blue cart: Household garbage, waxed cardboard, yard waste (grass, leaves or branches), plastic bags - (plastic bags are collected at most grocery motor oil containers, ceramic or ovenware dishes, Styrofoam, packing peanuts)



Trash collection will be Monday, July 3rd due to the holiday on Tuesday.

Get Empowered by using See-Click-Fix!

See-Click-Fix is an app which empowers citizens with a way to report issues needing the City's attention. YOU can easily report items such as street light outages, poor roadway conditions, drainage problems, graffiti, landscaping on public or private property, etc. These deficiency or service needed reports can be made anonymously or through the creation of a personal account. Entries into the system can be made via See-Click-Fix's cell phone app, tablet, or computer. This program is extremely valuable because it provides an easy way for you to help maintain the appearance of your neighborhood and help your community "Take A Bite Out Of Crime".
