Spring is already turning to summer. What a great time to be in Wellington Woods...wonderful landscapes, beaches, a great resort area and an abundance of quality shopping, dining, and fun activities.

As we start to dig into this fun it's also time to get our socials, landscapes, annual dues, scholarship awards and new neighbor appreciations in order. I'm sure there are more details about all within this newsletter, however, I wanted to highlight our healthy finances and their allocations.

Currently we have \$6,928 in our overall account with \$992 dedicated towards the scholarship funds and the remaining amount within our general and capital funds. During our recent meeting it was determined we have \$3,000 in our capital fund whereas we have a goal to reach \$10,000 by the end of 2025. Upon reaching it we will be using these funds to enhance the brick entrance which was originally built in 1971 and is in need of major repairs/updates. This should enhance our neighborhood's appeal for all.

Our general fund is used for expenses like median lighting we fund 365 days per year, landscaping plants/services for both entrances and mowing services for the median on North Wolfsnare. In addition, we provide pet waste station supplies and we arrange and fund supplies for driveway socials and our annual Fall Festival.

We have been very fortunate with neighbors volunteering to mow the median, plant and maintain entrances, both of which saves us a lot of money which have added up nicely to our funds. Yes, we still have a professional landscape company that assists when needed, which we will continue, however I would like to encourage any willing to volunteer.
